**LODGING**

A block of rooms is reserved for the meeting, March 8 (Tuesday) through March 10 (Thursday), 2016 at the Holiday Inn Capital Plaza. The special block room rate for the meeting will be honored one day before and one day after the meeting dates on a space available basis.
